CAG to audit 'ease of living' in 101 cities

Urban governance key focus area of upcoming reviews

New Delhi, November 16

THE COMPTROLLER AND Auditor General (CAG) of India, K Sanjay Murthy, on Sunday announced a fresh set of national audit priorities centred on improving "Ease of Living" across 101 cities, alongside key reviews in MSME facilitation, primary education and multimodal logistics, with a special focus on the Indian Railways.

The initiative seeks to align audit efforts with India's long-term development goals and evaluate progress in areas directly affecting citizens' daily lives, business efficiency, and logistics competitiveness.

With more than half of India's population projected to reside in urban areas by 2047, the CAG said it is reinvigorating audits of urban local bodies to assess the quality of life in 101 cities. The exercise will examine infrastructure, service delivery, environmental sustainability, and local economic growth under the broader Ease of Living theme.

"Our findings will provide actionable insights on urban issues, impacting the daily lives of more than 400 million urban citizens," Murthy said.

Another major audit priority is the micro, small and medium enterprises (MSME) sector, which plays a pivotal role in employment and exports. The CAG has initiated a dedicated audit on Ease of Doing Business for MSMEs, focusing on paperless and faceless processes, user-friendly digital systems, and the

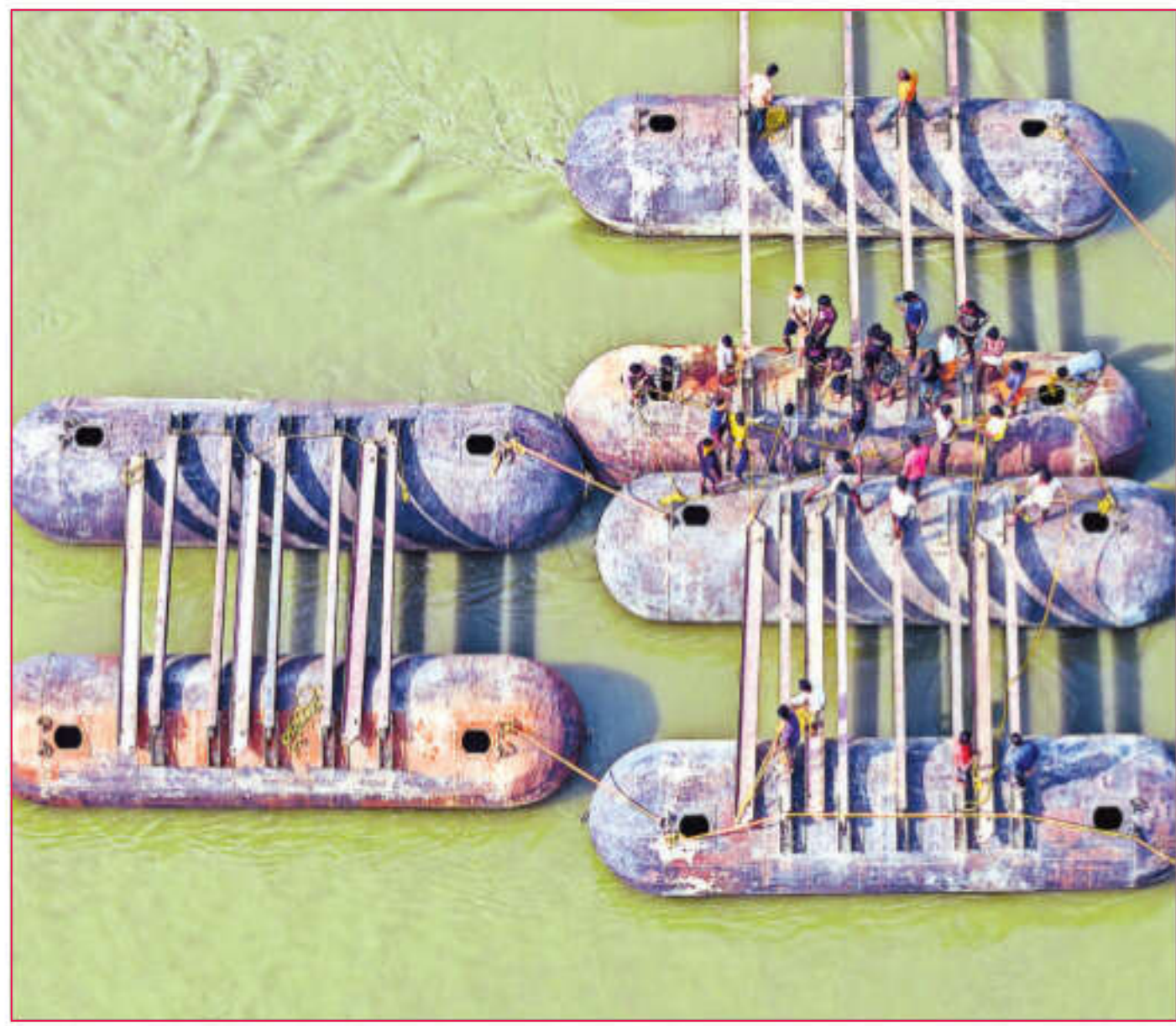
effectiveness of grievance-redressal mechanisms. The review aims to identify bottlenecks and recommend reforms to strengthen the small-business ecosystem.

Human capital development has also been recognised as a national imperative. To support the government's goal of improving foundational skills among schoolchildren, the CAG has launched a pan-India audit of Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN). The audit will assess early-grade learning outcomes and suggest measures to achieve national FLN targets—seen as crucial for India's journey toward developed-nation status.

On infrastructure and connectivity, the CAG plans a comprehensive audit of the government's multimodal transport and logistics initiatives under the PM Gati Shakti framework, with particular emphasis on the Indian Railways. The review will evaluate coordination among ports, railways, freight operators, and terminals to gauge progress on seamless multimodal connectivity—critical for lowering logistics costs.

To strengthen institutional capacity, the CAG is also building a future-ready audit ecosystem. In collaboration with IIT Madras, it has launched a certification programme in data science, AI, and cybersecurity for IT auditing.

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Be vigilant on SIR exercise: Udhayanidhi

TAMIL NADU DEPUTY Chief Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin on Sunday appealed to DMK workers to stay vigilant about the ongoing SIR exercise in the state. He urged the partymen to take up intensive field work in the coming days to ensure that the DMK forms the government for the seventh time after the 2026 Assembly polls.

"You should stay vigilant about the ongoing Special Intensive Revision. Another 40-45 days are there to go for completion of this exercise. You must ensure that the details of a genuine voter do not get deleted, and fake voter names should not be added during the exercise," he said.

Participating at the valedictory ceremony of DMK 75 'Arivu Thiruvizha' Knowledge Festival' which was inaugu-

rated by Chief Minister MK Stalin on November 8, Udhayanidhi claimed it was for the first time a political party has conducted such an event on politics. The event was organised by DMK Youth Wing and held at Valluvar Kottam in the city. "Normally, at a book fair, you tend to see separate sections, like cookery, science among others. But in this book fair, you get all the necessary details about politics," he said.

Taking a dig on AIADMK, he said, "This fair encourages DMK partymen to understand about Tamil Nadu politics and history of political leaders. Whereas opposition parties like AIADMK do not conduct such events as they fear that their partymen would become intellectual and will have knowledge about politics." —PTI

Andhra fiscal indicators show 'weakness': Jagan cites CAG data

YSRCP SUPREMO YS Jagan Mohan Reddy on Sunday alleged that Andhra Pradesh's fiscal indicators reflect "weakness" pointing to the Comptroller and Auditor General's (CAG) data for the first half of FY26.

The former chief minister noted that the figures released by CAG for the six-month period

convey the actual state of affairs.

"The state's own tax revenues grew only 7.03% y-o-y in the first half, while the combined GST and Sales Tax revenues increased by a mere 2.85%," Reddy said in a post on 'X'. According to him, these figures run contrary to the assurances given by the TDP-led

alliance that government revenues would see rapid expansion under their governance.

He said CAGR of the state's own tax revenues over the two-year period from FY24 to FY26 stands at only 2.75%, reflecting a far weaker fiscal performance than what the government has been projecting. —PTI

SC to hear on stubble burning plea today

THE SUPREME COURT is slated to hear on Monday a plea related to stubble burning that has been further worsening the air quality levels in Delhi-NCR.

The top court had earlier asked the Punjab and Haryana governments to apprise it about the action taken to control the situation.

A bench comprising Chief Justice BR Gavai and justices K Vinod Chandran and NV Anjaria had earlier agreed to hear the plea on November 17.

"Let Punjab and Haryana governments respond on steps taken to control stubble burning," the CJI had said.

Earlier on November 3, the top court directed the Commission for Air Quality Management (CAQM) to file an affidavit detailing the steps it has taken so far to prevent the air pollution situation in Delhi-NCR from deteriorating further.

The bench was hearing the MC Mehta case and had said that the authorities must act proactively and not wait for pollution levels to reach a "severe" stage.

Amicus curiae Singh had flagged media reports indicating that several air quality monitoring stations in Delhi were not functioning during the Diwali period.

"There are newspapers after newspapers saying that monitoring stations are non-functional. If the monitoring stations are not even functioning, we don't even know when to implement GRAP (graded response action plan)... Out of 37 monitoring stations, only nine were functioning continuously on the day of Diwali," she said.

The amicus urged the bench to ensure that CAQM submits clear data and an action plan.

However, Additional Solicitor General Aishwarya Bhati assured the bench that the agencies concerned will file the required report.
