Sub: Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the Remote e-Voting and e-Voting conducted at the Sixty Second (62<sup>nd</sup>) Annual General Meeting (AGM) of Kothari Sugars and Chemicals Limited held on Thursday, August 10, 2023 at 2.00 P.M. (IST) through Video Conferencing (VC)/ Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM).

- 1. We M. Alagar & Associates, Practising Company Secretaries, Chennai were appointed by the Board of Directors of Kothari Sugars and Chemicals Limited ("the Company") vide resolution dated May 30, 2023 for the purpose of scrutinizing the votes cast through remote e-Voting and e-Voting at 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual General Meeting ("AGM") on the resolutions contained in the Notice dated May 30, 2023, as prescribed under Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") as amended from time to time, read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("LODR Regulations"), placed for the approval of members of the Company, be carried out in a fair and transparent manner.
- 2. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs vide its Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 08, 2020, Circular No.17/2020 dated April 13, 2020 Circular No. 20/2020 dated May 05, 2020, Circular No. 02/2021 dated January 13, 2021, Circular No. 02/2022 dated May 05, 2022, Circular No. 10/2022 dated December 28, 2022 (Collectively referred to as "MCA Circulars") and Securities and Exchange Board of India ("SEBI") vide its Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 dated May 13, 2022 and Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated January 05, 2023 (collectively referred to as "SEBI Circulars"), has permitted conducting the AGM through VC or OAVM without the physical presence of the members for the meeting at a common venue. The AGM was held without the physical presence of the members of the Company, hence the facility for appointment of proxies by the members was also dispensed with.

Members attended the meeting through VC or OAVM had been counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.

- 3. As required under Section 101 of the Act read with aforementioned circulars issued by MCA and SEBI, the Notice of 62<sup>nd</sup> AGM along with Explanatory Statement under Section 102 of the Act was sent to the Members by permitted means as per the Circulars in respect of the resolutions passed at the AGM of the Company. The Notice was also published in "Financial Express" (English) and "Makkal Kural" (Tamil) on July 18, 2023.
- 4. The Company had availed the voting facility offered by Central Depository Service (India) Limited ("CDSL"), for facilitating remote e-Voting and e-Voting at the AGM, to enable the members to exercise their right to vote by electronic means.
- 5. The members of the Company holding shares as on the "Cut-off" date (i.e. on Thursday, August 03, 2023) were entitled to vote on the resolution as set out in the AGM Notice.
- 6. The remote e-Voting commenced on Sunday, August 06, 2023 at 9:00 AM (IST) and ended on Wednesday, August 09, 2023 at 5:00 PM (IST) and the CDSL e-Voting platform was closed in due time.
- 7. The members who had voted by remote e-Voting through the facility provided by CDSL had been blocked and only those members who were present at the AGM through VC and who had not voted through remote e-Voting were allowed to cast their votes through e-Voting system during the AGM.
- 8. The Company has conducted the  $62^{nd}$  AGM with the presence of requisite quorum throughout the meeting.
- 9. The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and Rules made thereunder, the circulars issued by the MCA and SEBI and the applicable regulations of the SEBI LODR Regulations relating to remote e-Voting and e-Voting at the AGM on the resolutions contained in the aforesaid Notice of the AGM.
- 10. Our responsibility as a Scrutinizer is to scrutinize and ensure that the vote cast through remote e-Voting and e-Voting at AGM is done in a fair and transparent manner and to make a Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the votes cast "in favour" or "against" the resolutions, based on the reports generated from the system related to remote e-Voting and e-Voting as per the facility provided by CDSL, the agency engaged by the Company to provide remote e-Voting facility and e-Voting facility at the AGM.
